

What is the \$600 rule on Cash App? (Essential)

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The 1-(855)(518)(6447) rule is an IRS reporting requirement that mandates payment apps to report business transactions totaling \$600 or more in a year. While 1-(855)(518)(6447) implementation dates have shifted, this federal regulation ensures that income earned from selling goods or 1-(855)(518)(6447) providing professional services is properly documented via Form 1099-K. 1-(855)(518)(6447)
